## MARCH COMMENTS FROM AL –

Ginger showed up at church one Sunday. She had pink hair and a very bad attitude. I found her after church & welcomed her. She was a drug addict & a prostitute, & she was living in a cheap rundown trailer. I told her she could come to our food bank, which she did the next day. She kept coming to church... Then we did not see her for a few weeks, and we sadly found out she was killed by a man who took her money.

About 3 months ago someone gave us about 100 outdoor chairs for use in a big open space surrounded by oak trees. We told the people who were coming for food that we would be having a chapel time first, and to my slight surprise, the people kept coming for food. A few other ministers help with giving short chapel messages. At least 200 people have prayed to receive Christ as their Savior. Many are praying and getting closer to the Lord. We call our chapel time “Church in the Oaks”.

Please pray for our staff. We have gotten very busy dealing with many who have drug problems. We are so thankful to God for all the victories we are now seeing on a regular basis.

## APRIL COMMENTS FROM AL –

Most likely there would be no Safehouse, if I would not have gone to the Billy Graham Crusade when he was in the Twin Cities of Minneapolis/St. Paul. It was July 15, 1961. It was the night I came to Christ.

Thank you for giving to Safehouse. There would also be no Safehouse without you and others like you. We opened our first home in 1972. This past year has been the most productive. Last Saturday we had a huge crowd show up for food at our outside “Church in the Oaks”. Pastor Eddie Lamb was the preacher that day. So many of the people prayed that it was a roar of noise (good noise). Close to 100 people prayed. We get several hundred people per week asking for food, and most of them come to Christ at our “Church in the Oaks”. Thank you again. We could not do what we do without you.
