Remember those who are in prison, as though in prison with them. —Hebrews 13:3

On May 7, EPC Teaching Elder Andrew Brunson returns to court in Turkey on charges of terrorism, espionage, & attempting to convert Turks to Christianity. If convicted, he faces 35 years in prison. Please pray these Scriptures.

FOR ANDREW:

Isaiah 40:31 “Those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength.”

Isaiah 42:3 “A bruised reed He will not break, and a smoldering wick He will not snuff out. In faithfulness, He will establish justice.”

Luke 4:18 “The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because He has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners & recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free.”
