Two years ago, Uriah & Marissa started the process of adoption, believing God was calling them to pursue another adoption from China. However, that door was closed as they realized how complicated and expensive the process was while living outside of either China or US.

A few months later at a homeschool conference a family asked them to consider adopting in Hungary, which is mostly free. For the last 2 years, following prayer, they decided to be faithful to each step God put before them, filling out papers, attending classes, talking to a psychologist, sitting in front of a judge, keeping various appointments and home visits. Two days before Thanksgiving they received a match to a little 2-yr-old boy. They met and played with him for a little over an hour. The next step, which started Jan. 2nd, is to do a week-long visit every day to his foster home.

“Please pray for us as we have some practical things we need to get ready, as well as for our hearts. The transition will be hard for our little boy’s heart, as he will have to say goodbye to his foster family, and for us and our children as we adjust to adding him to our lives. We are so thankful for God’s call on our lives as we live out Jesus’ love through adoption. Details & pictures to come when we are able to do so.”

Other Praises & Prayer requests

God is continuing to show us how He is using the Craving Grace material in the lives of women at our church; two more video training tools have been translated into Mandarin, “How to Lead a Small Group” and “The Vision of Expedition”; pray for Uriah to get his Russian visa approved & receive his passport back from the US without issue (via FedEx); Ruthie (Marissa’s friend & mentor) and her husband will be in the area and available to train Nat’l leaders in the Craving Grace content.
